Introduction:

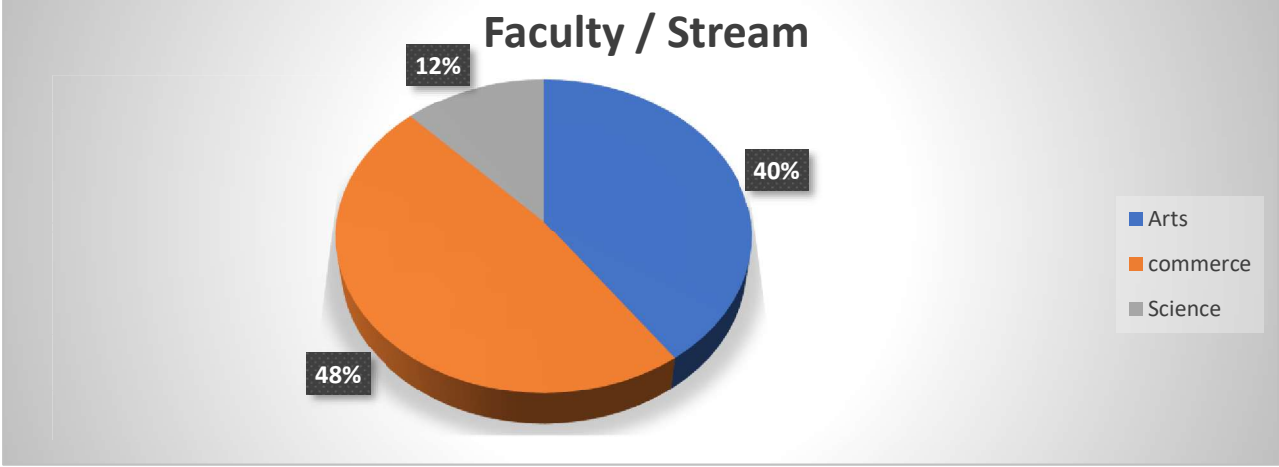
Feedback plays an important role in improving the curriculum as well as in the development of the educational institution. The College collects online feedback on various curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the students, alumni, Faculty, and Employers. The feedback collected from the individuals has been analyzed and taken into consideration for the development of the curriculum.

Student Feedback:

The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education systems. From the current academic year, the college has started an online feedback system. We have collected online feedback from our undergraduate students and postgraduate students. We have received a total of 529 students' online feedback on the syllabus of the various programs designed by Mumbai University, Mumbai.

Faculty / Stream:

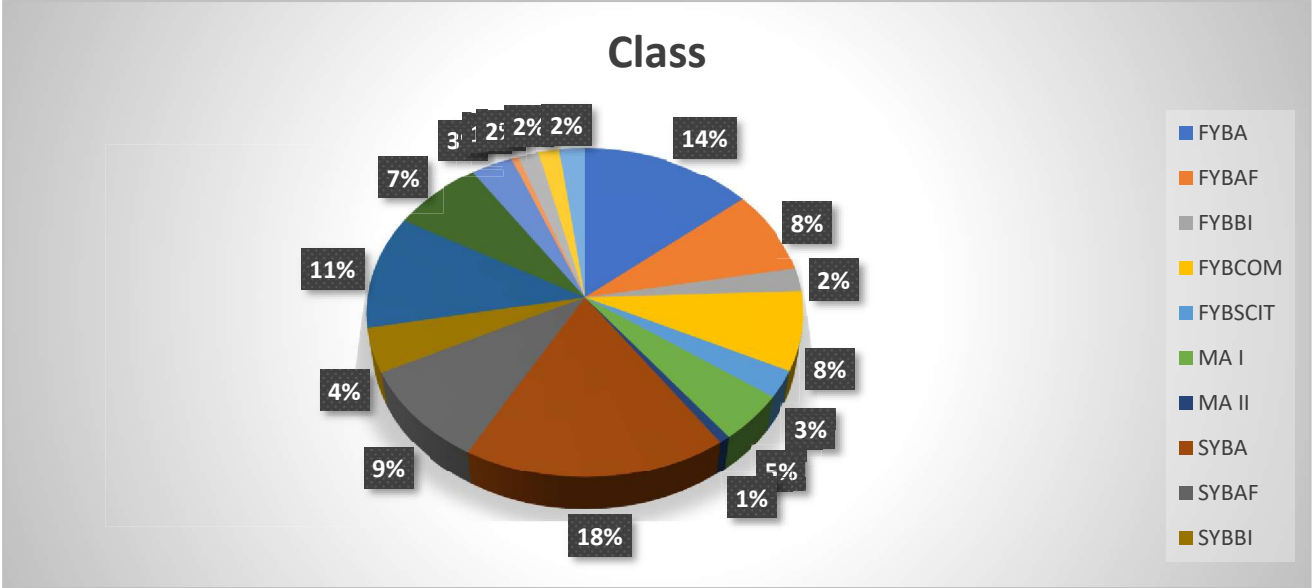
This academic year, students from Arts, Commerce, and Science participated in the online feedback process conducted by the college.



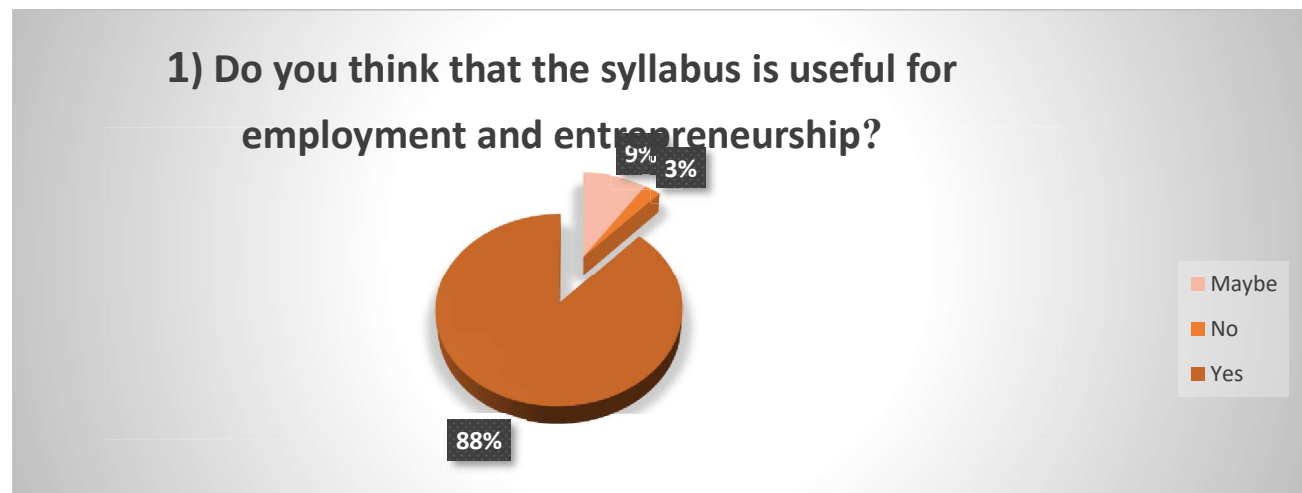
According to the above pie chart, 40% of the students in the arts branch gave their feedback on the course. Only 48% of commerce students gave feedback on their course. 12% of science students registered their participation.

Class:

Students of the first year, second year, and third year undergraduate classes of Arts, Commerce and Science Faculty, and the postgraduate first year and second-year classes of Arts submitted their feedback related to the curriculum. The following chart shows the feedback status of all the classes.

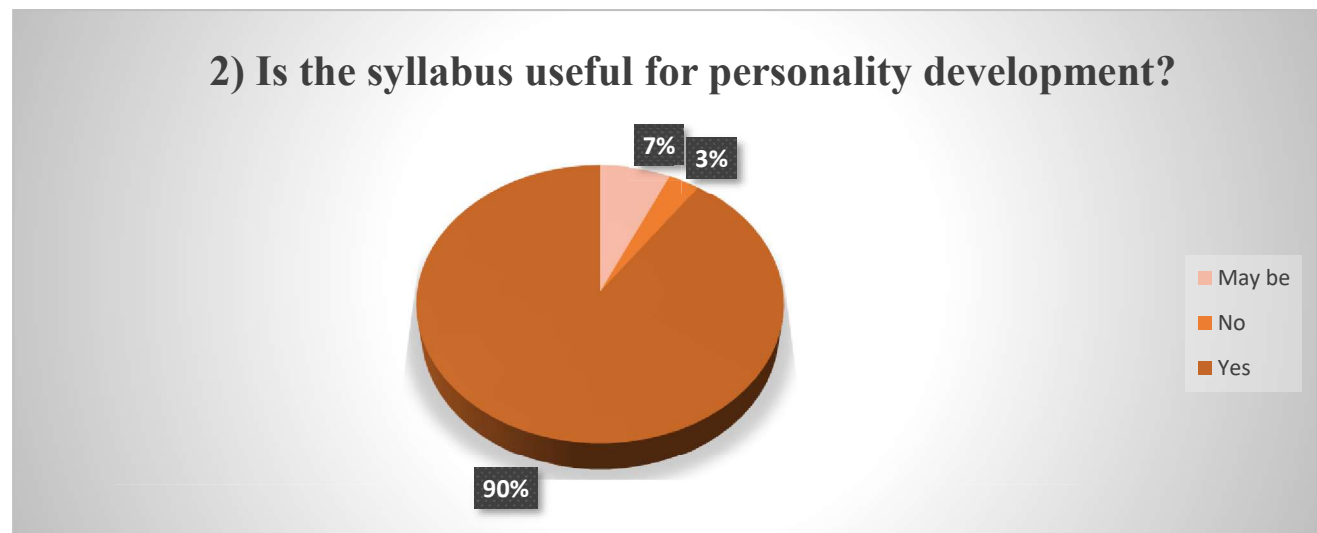


Employment and Entrepreneurship:



While evaluating the question on the syllabus, **‘Do you think that the syllabus is useful for employment and entrepreneurship?’** In answering this question 88% of students commented that the syllabus is useful for employment and entrepreneurship, 3% of students said that the course is not useful for employment and entrepreneurship and 9% of students are not sure whether the course is useful for employment and entrepreneurship.

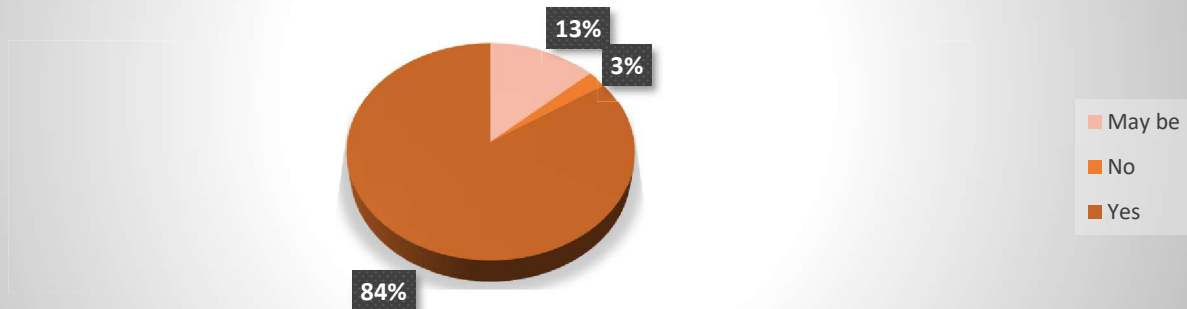
Personality Development:

Balance Between Theoretical and Practical Knowledge:

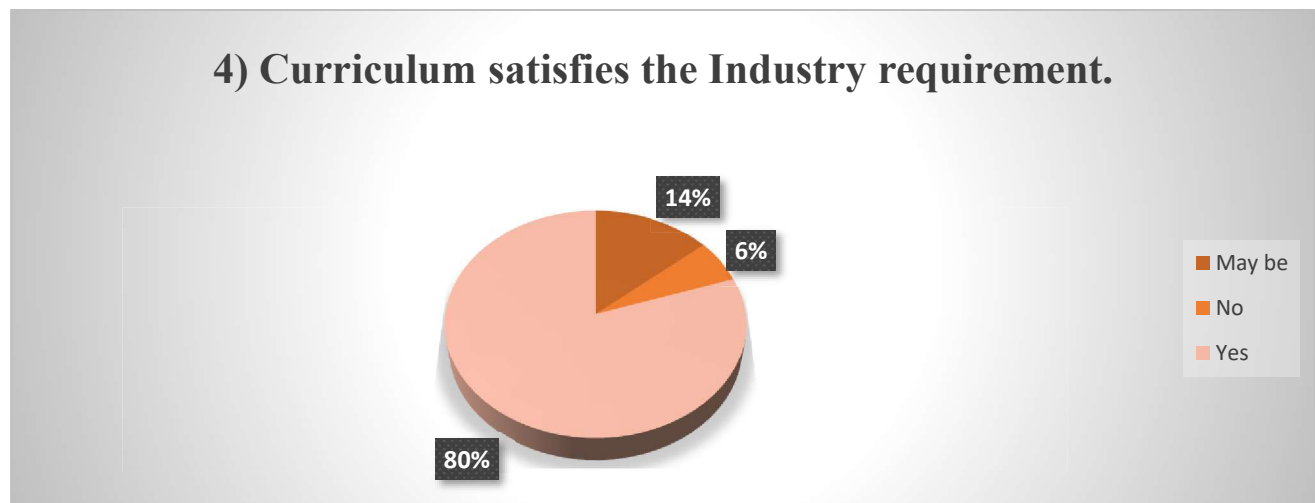
3) The syllabus has the right balance between theoretical and practical knowledge?

Curriculum Satisfies the Industry Requirement:

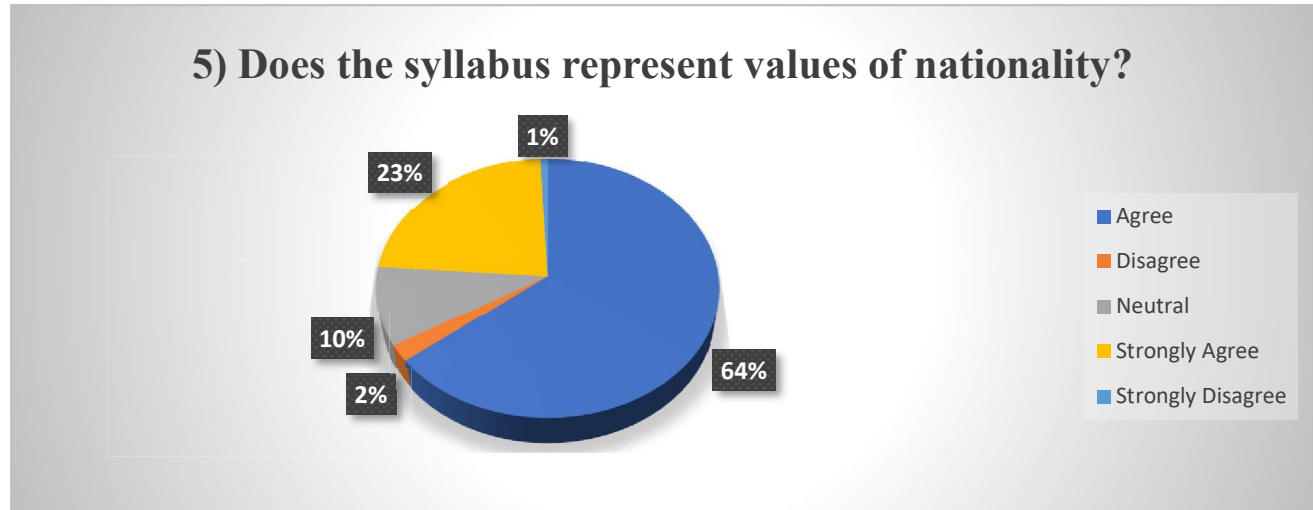
4) Curriculum satisfies the Industry requirement.

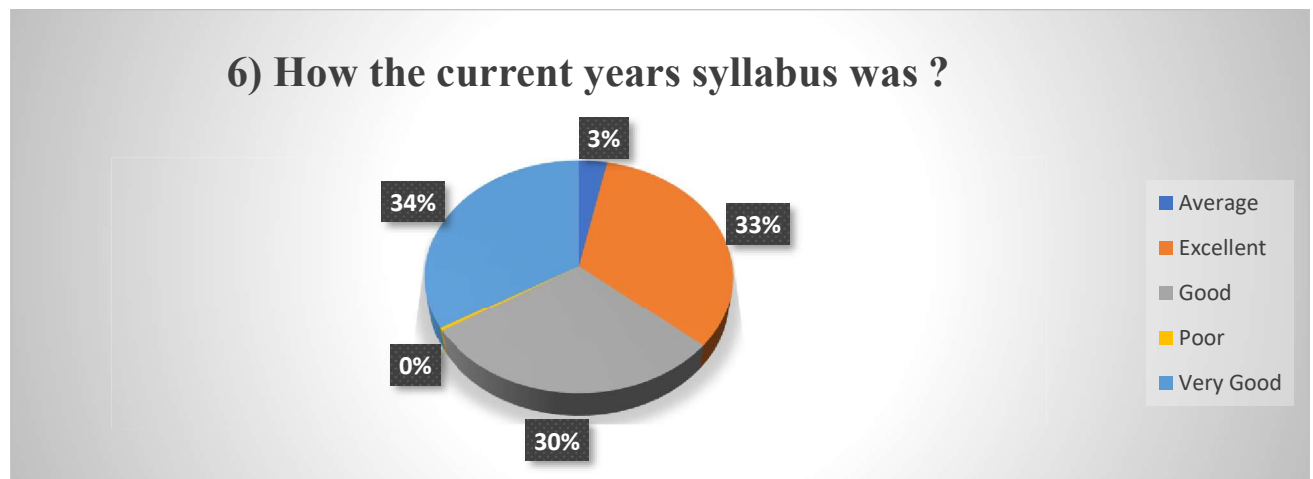
needs. The above chart shows that 5% of students do not agree with the above statement and 13% of students could not decide whether this curriculum meets industry needs.

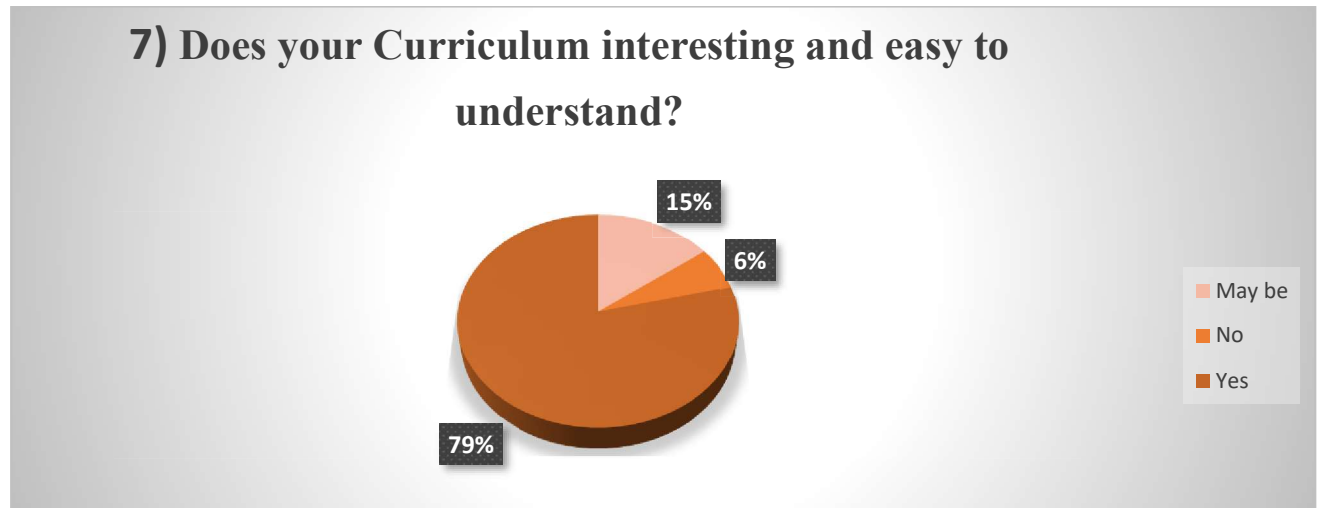
Current Years Syllabus:

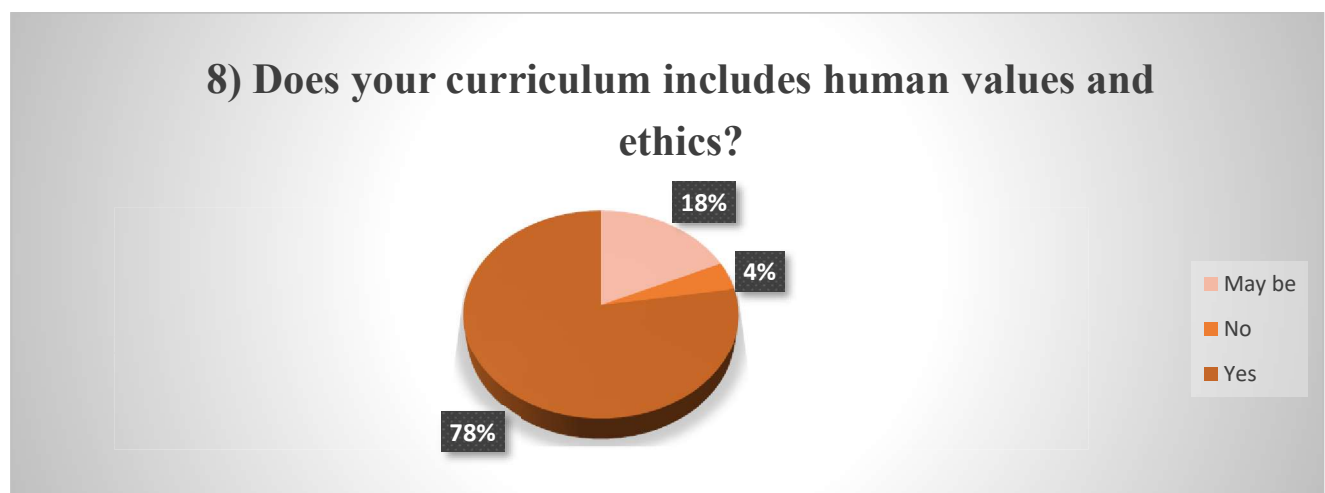
good and 30% of the students think that the syllabus is good. Overall, 97% of students are satisfied with the current year's syllabus.

Curriculum Interesting and Easy to Understand:



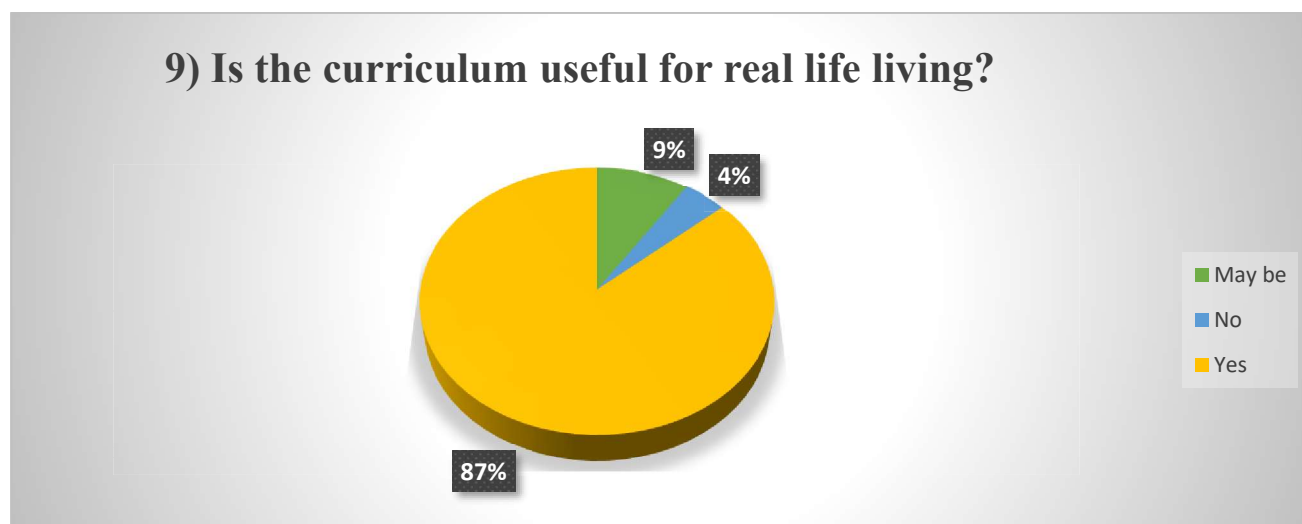

Curriculum Includes Human Values and Ethics:



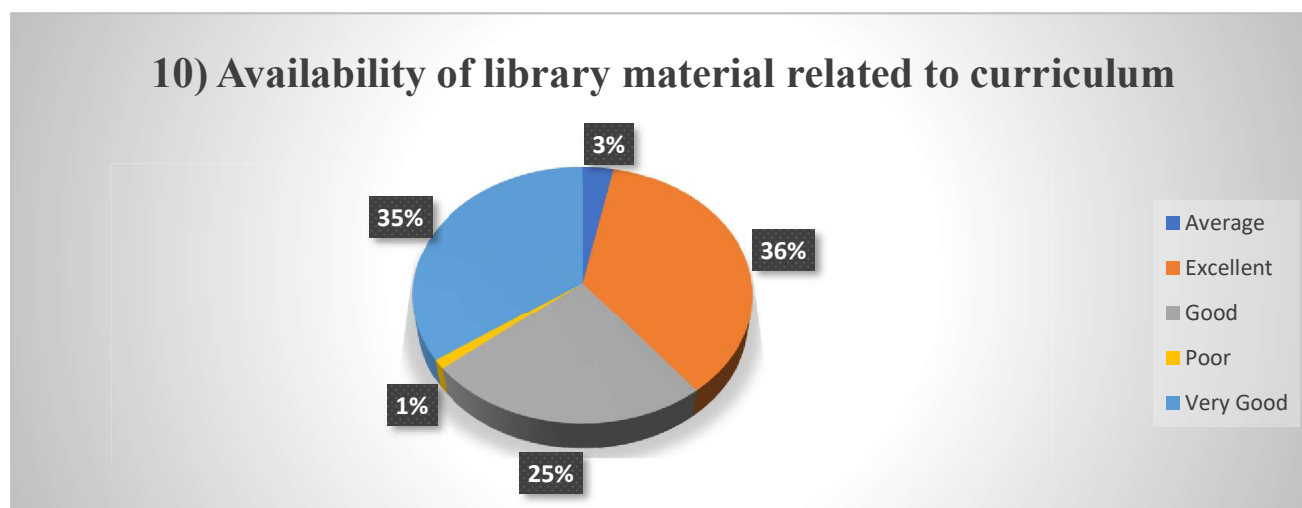

In the modern world, the curriculum should not only be a means of acquiring knowledge but also useful for real-life living. In this context, as shown in the above pie chart, 87% of the students believe that this course is useful for real life. 4% of students do not agree with the above statement. 9% of students may find this course useful for real-life living.

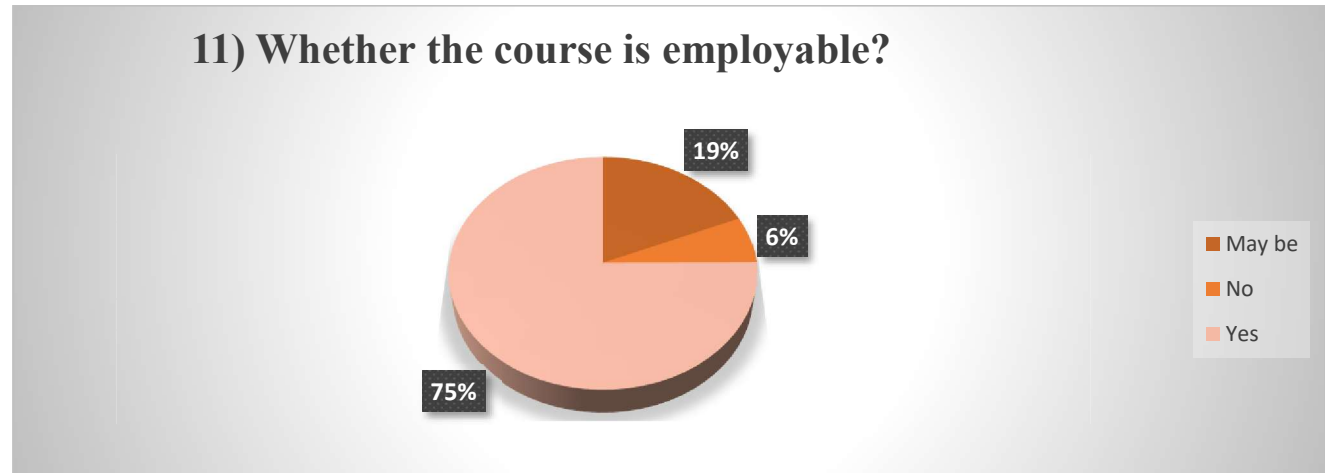
Availability of Library Material Related to Curriculum:



The library is the main source of knowledge for college students. In this view, the library has a fair number of books related to the curriculum. In this regard, 36% of the students said that the availability of textbooks and reference books related to the curriculum in the library is excellent. 35% of the students mentioned that the availability of textbooks and reference books related to the curriculum in the library was very good

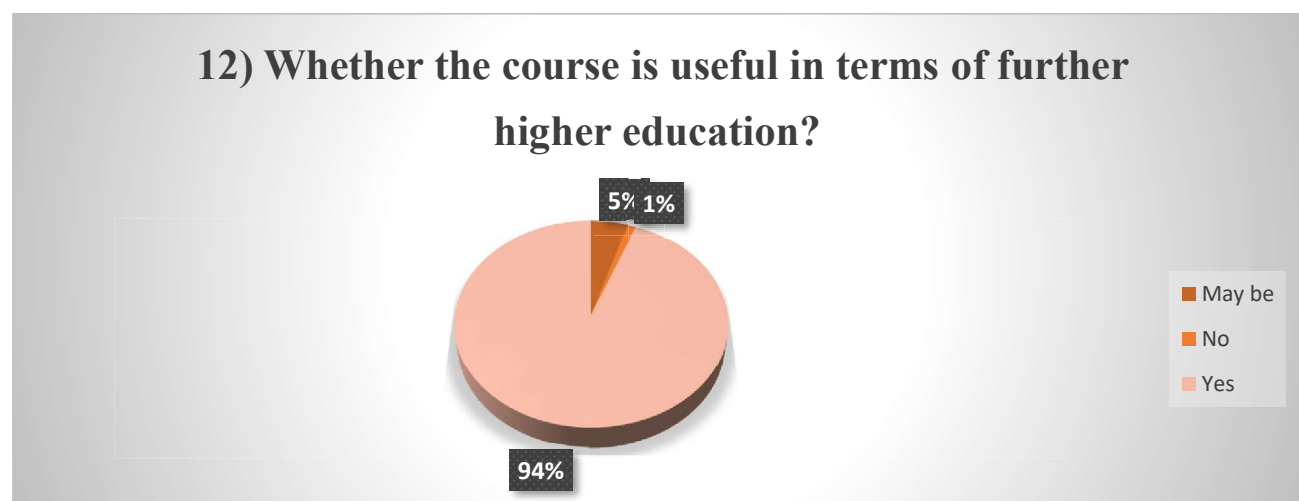
and 25% of the students mentioned that it was very good. Overall, 96% of the students expressed their opinion that there is sufficient availability of textbooks reference books in the library.

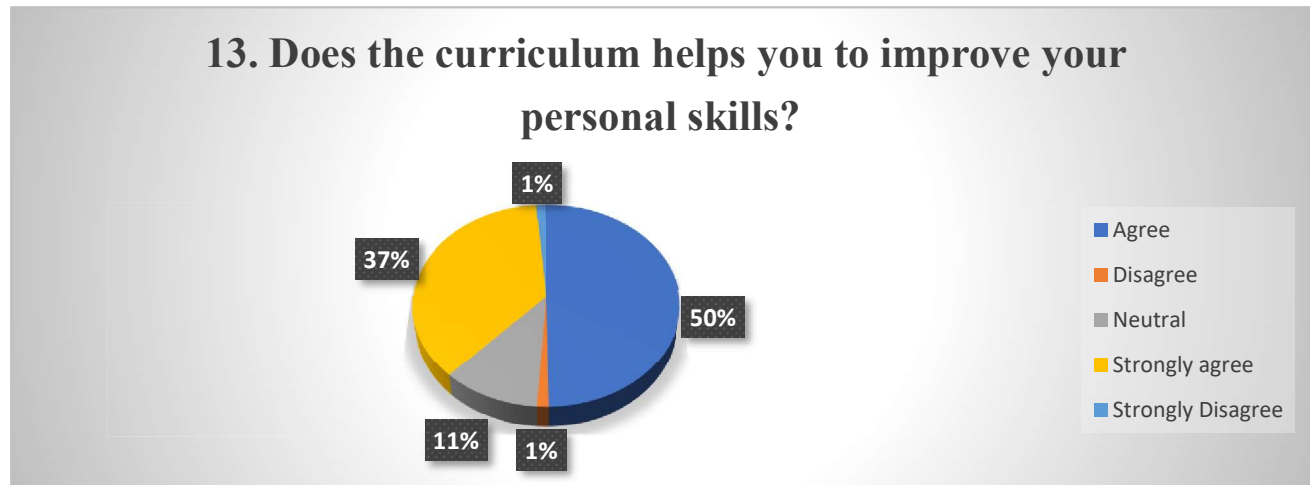
Course Is Useful in Terms of Further Higher Education



As shown in the above chart, 94% of the students mentioned that the course is useful for further higher education. According to 5% of students, the curriculum may

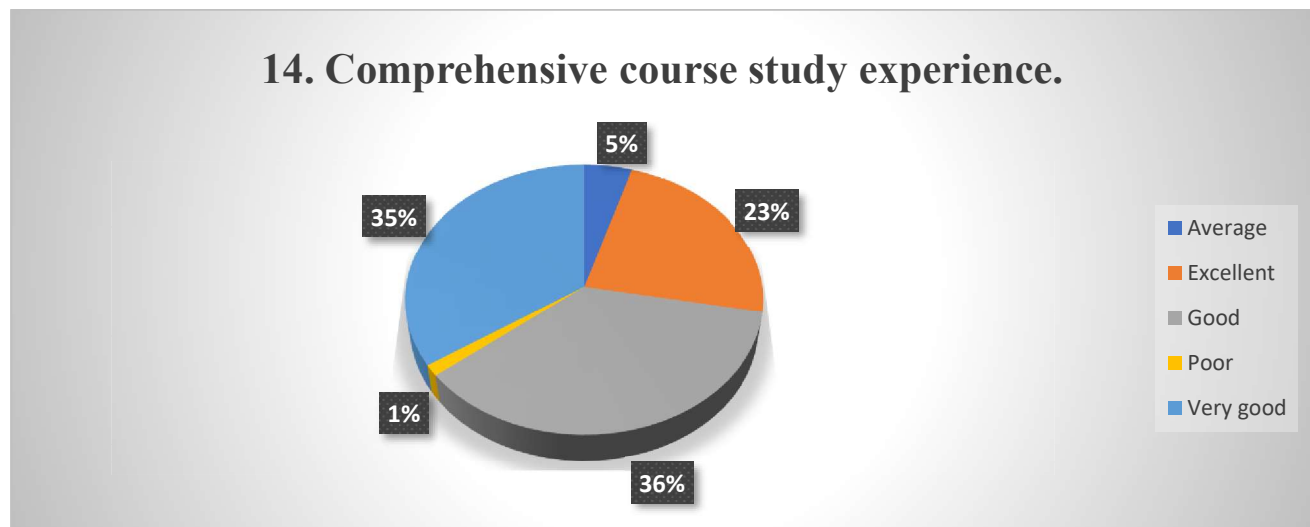
be useful for further higher education. 1% of students do not agree with the above statement.

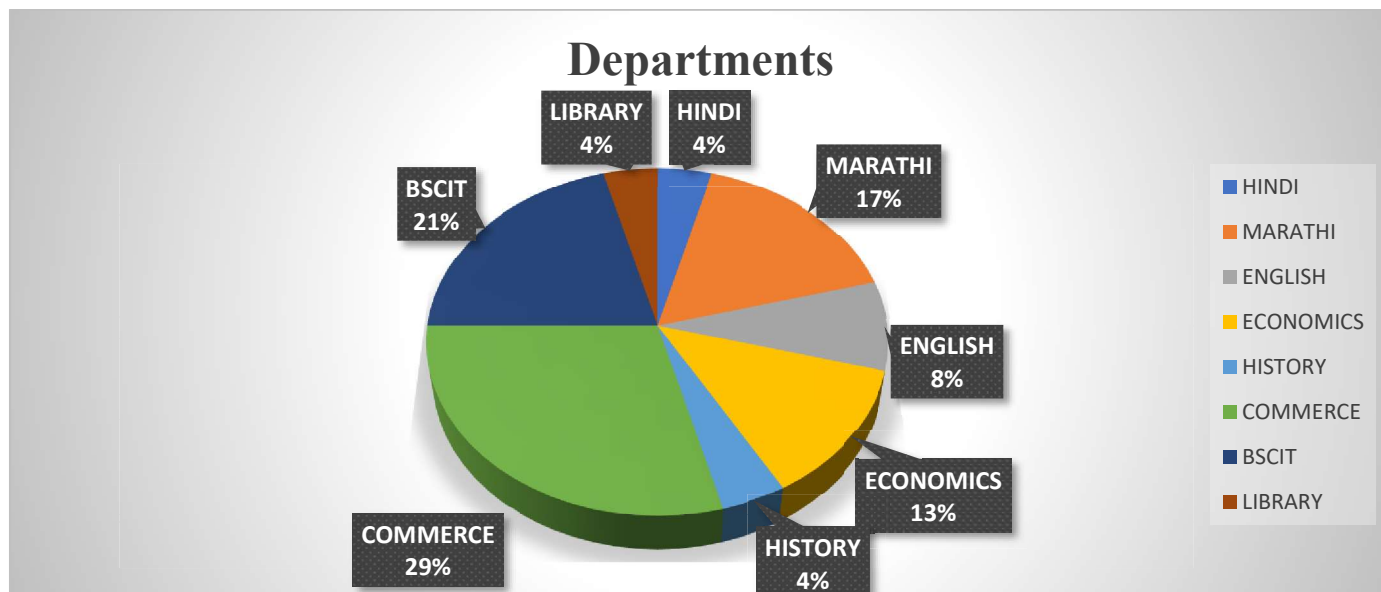
Introduction:

Teacher Feedback:

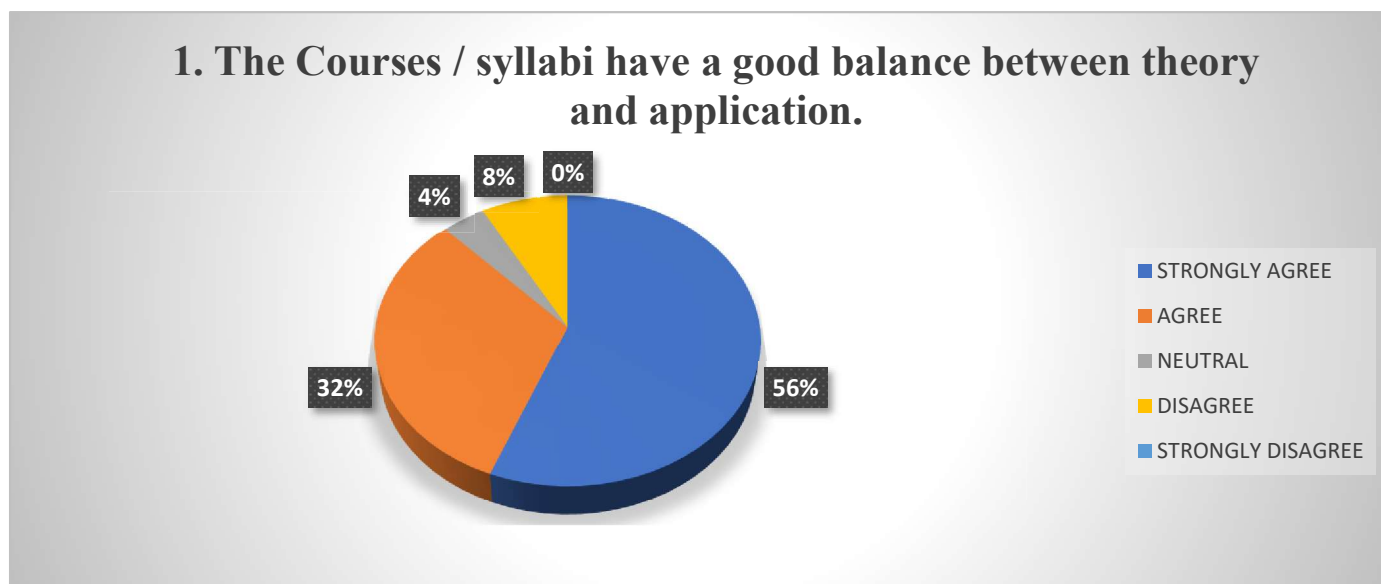

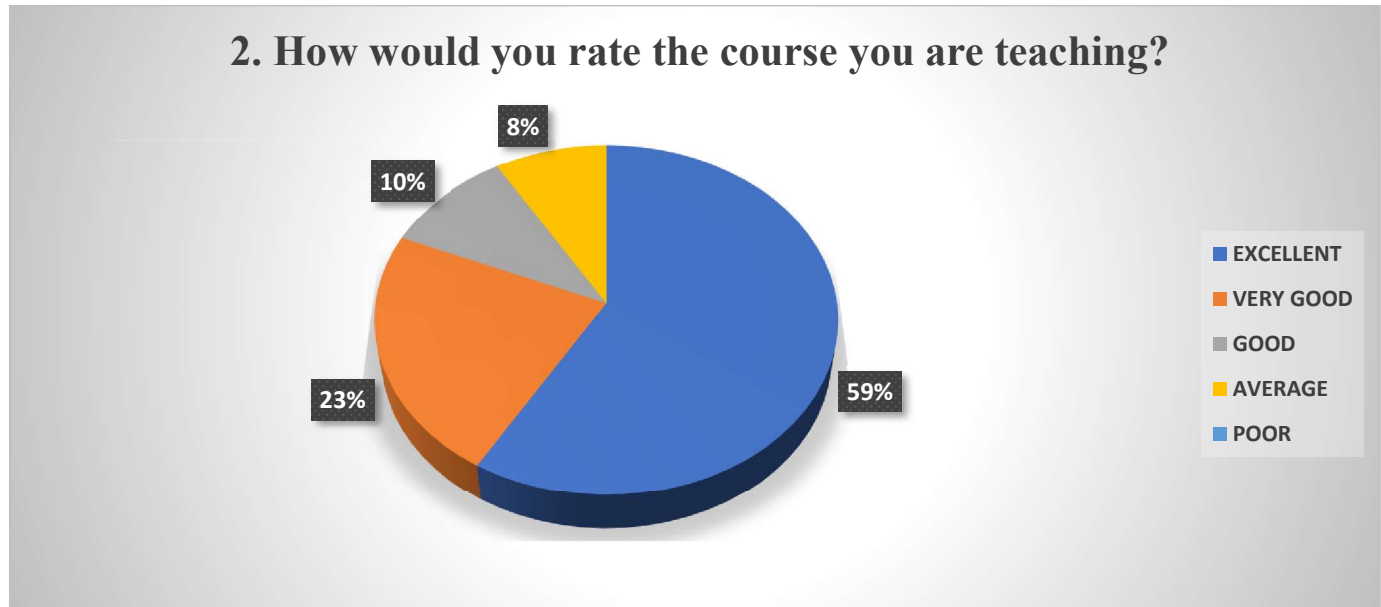
The Balance Between Theory and Application:

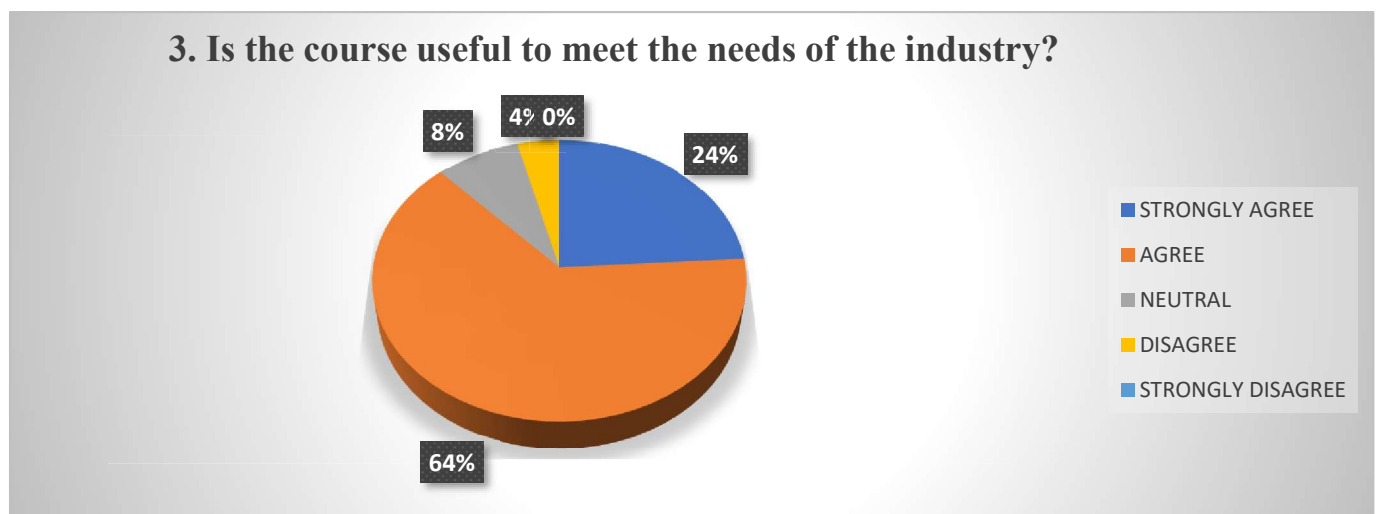
above chart shows that 8% of teachers do not agree with the above statement and 4% of teachers could not decide whether this syllabus has a good balance between theory and application.

Rate the Course:



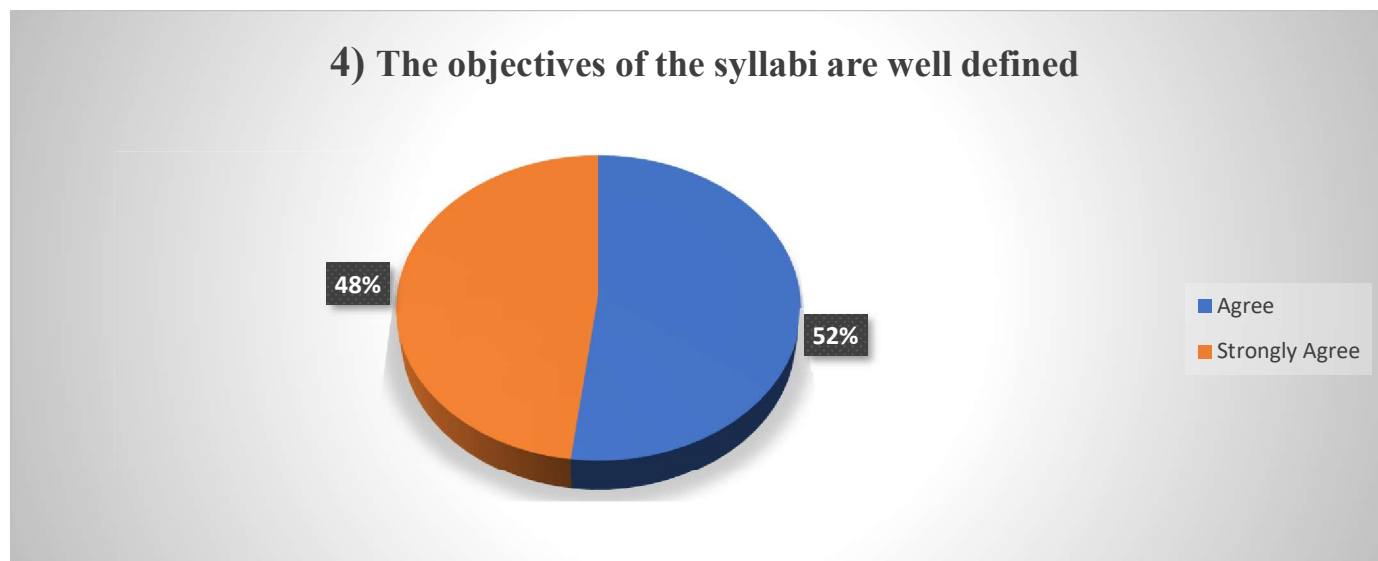

The Course Is Useful to Meet the Needs of The Industry:



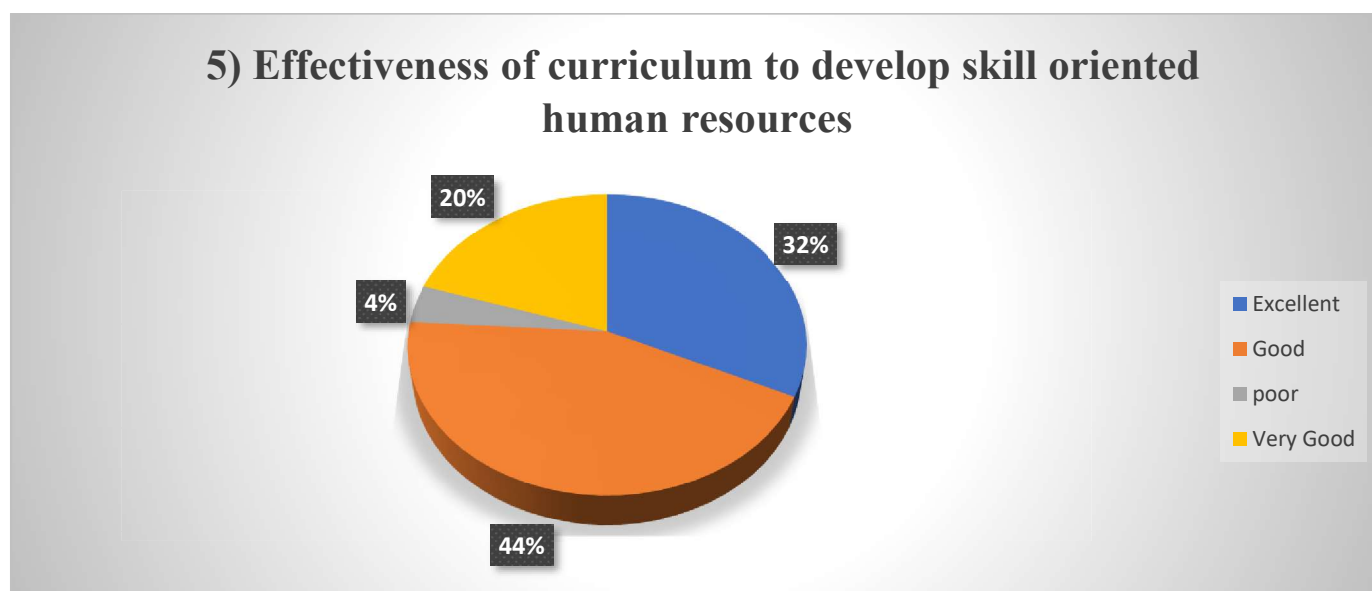

The Objectives of the Syllabi Are Well Defined:



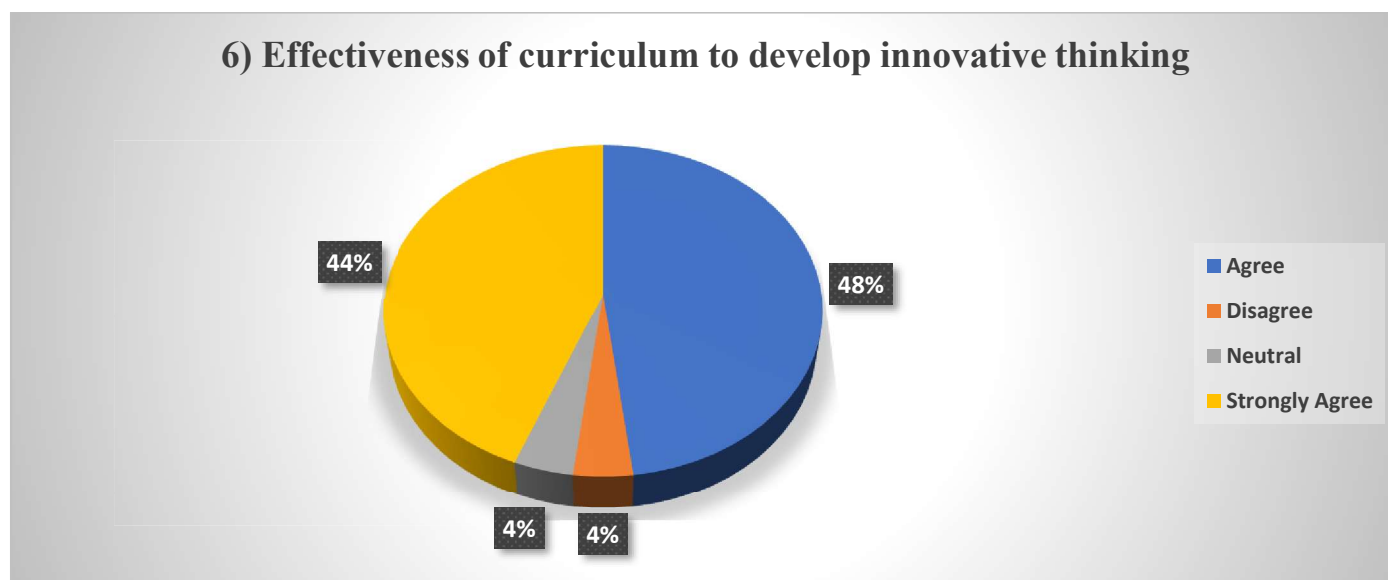
The above chart shows that all the teachers participating in the teacher's feedback agree with the above statement that the objectives of the syllabi are well defined.

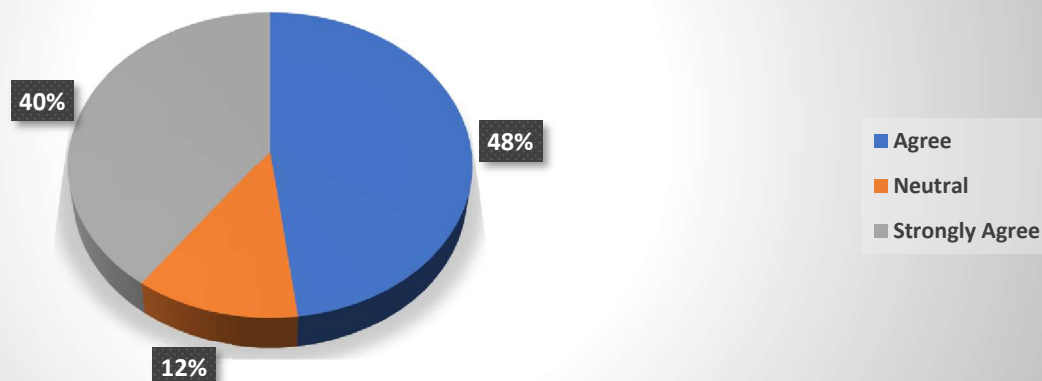
Effectiveness of Curriculum to Develop Innovative Thinking:

Comparison with Similar Programmes of Other Universities:

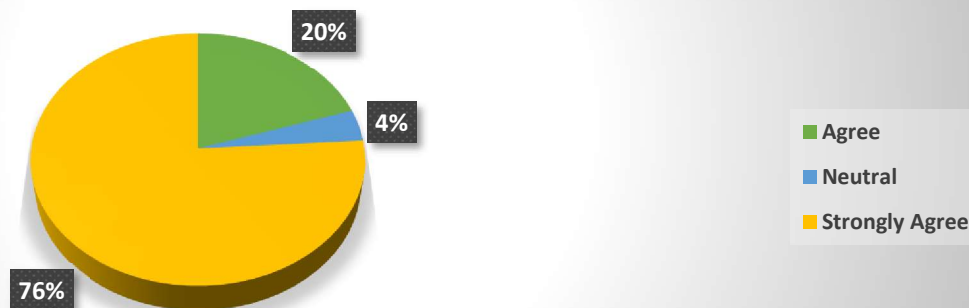
7) The programme and curriculum is enriched as compared to similar programme offered by other universities.

Availability of Sufficient Reference Material and Books:

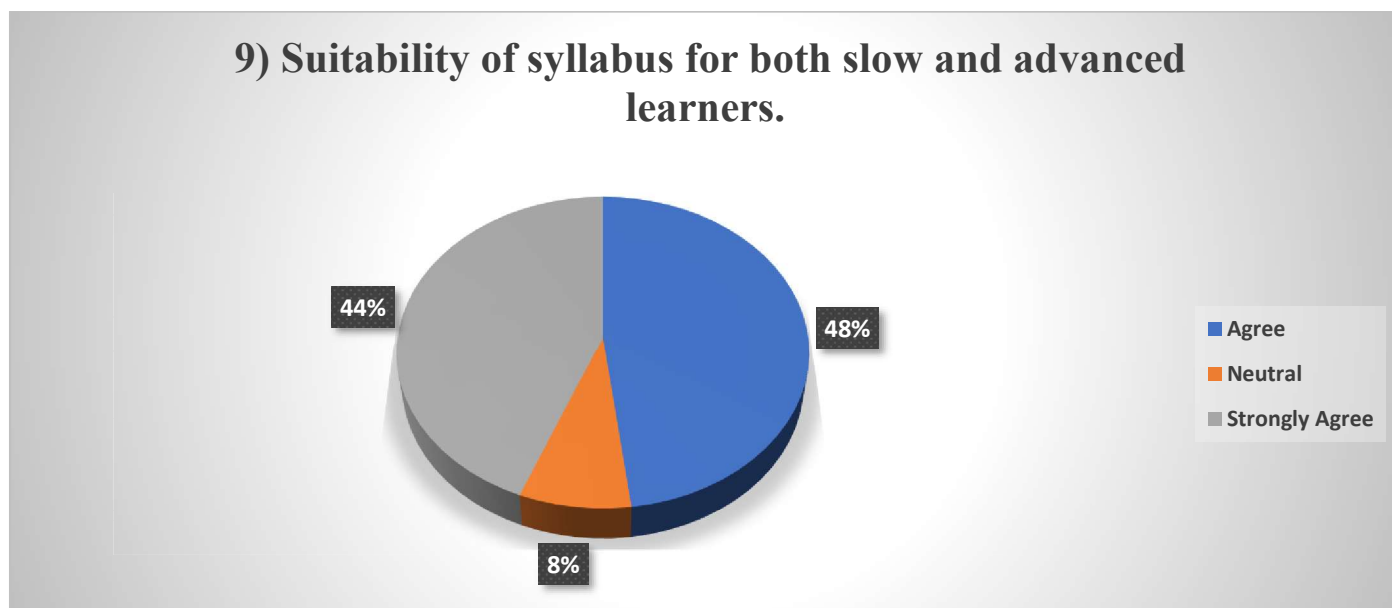
8) Sufficient reference material and books are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus.

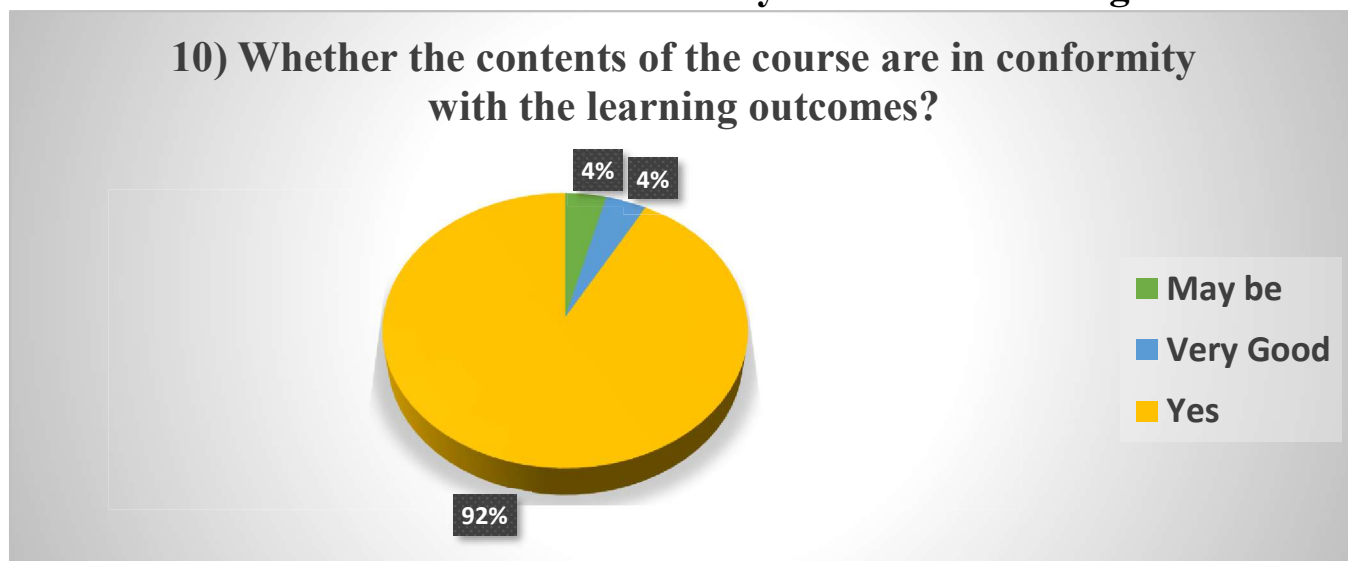
that adequate reference materials and books are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus. 4% of teachers are neutral about the above statement.

As shown in the above pie chart, 92% of teachers believe that the curriculum is suitable for both slow and advanced students. 8% of teachers remained neutral about the above statement.

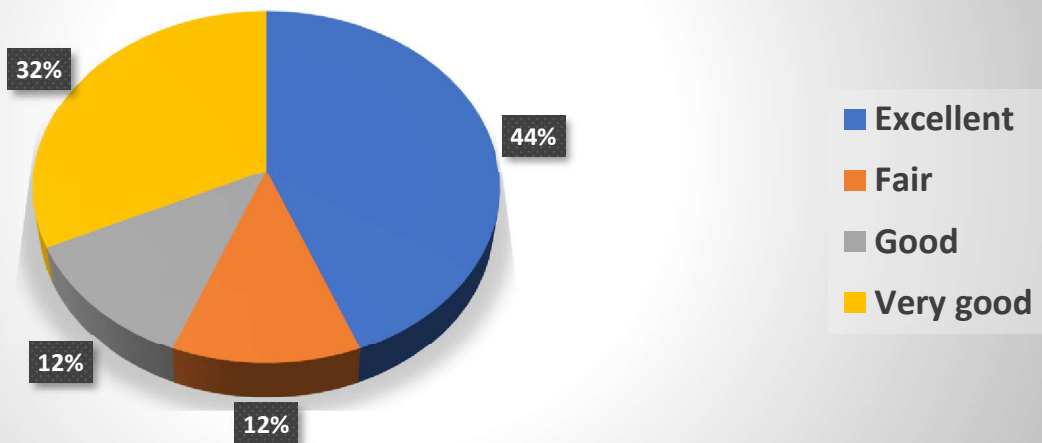
Contents of the Course Are in Conformity with The Learning Outcomes:

Sustainability of Evaluation System Adopted Under Syllabus:

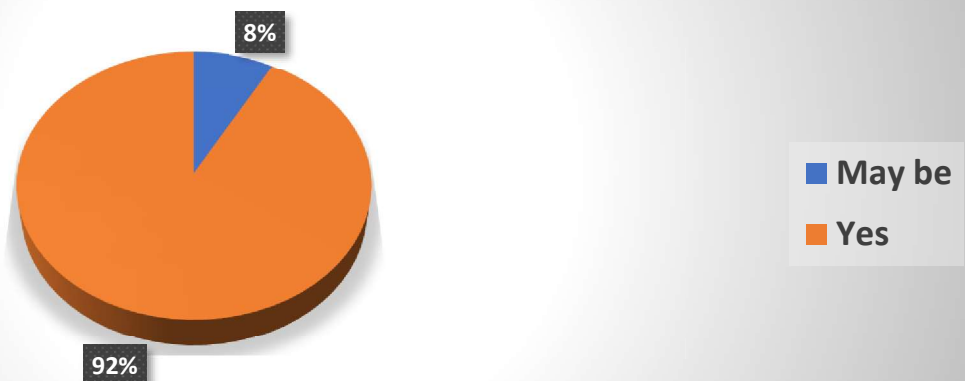
11) Sustainability of evaluation system adopted under syllabus.

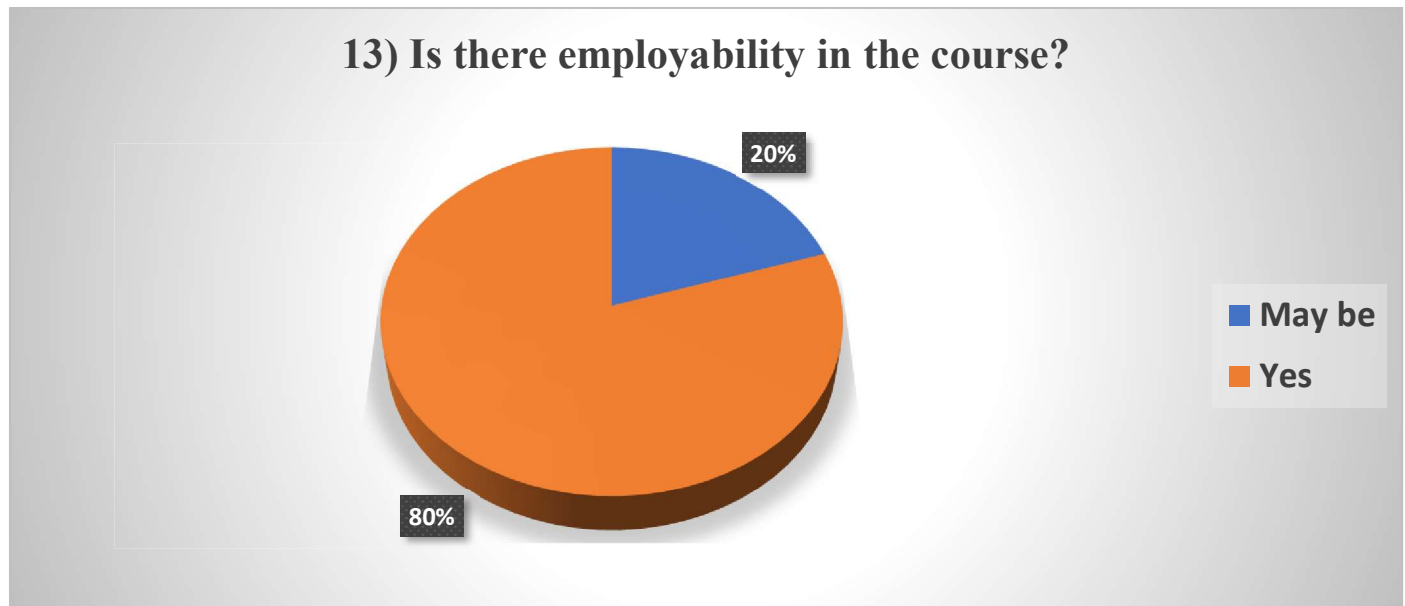
Syllabus Practically Useful:

12) Is the syllabus practically useful?



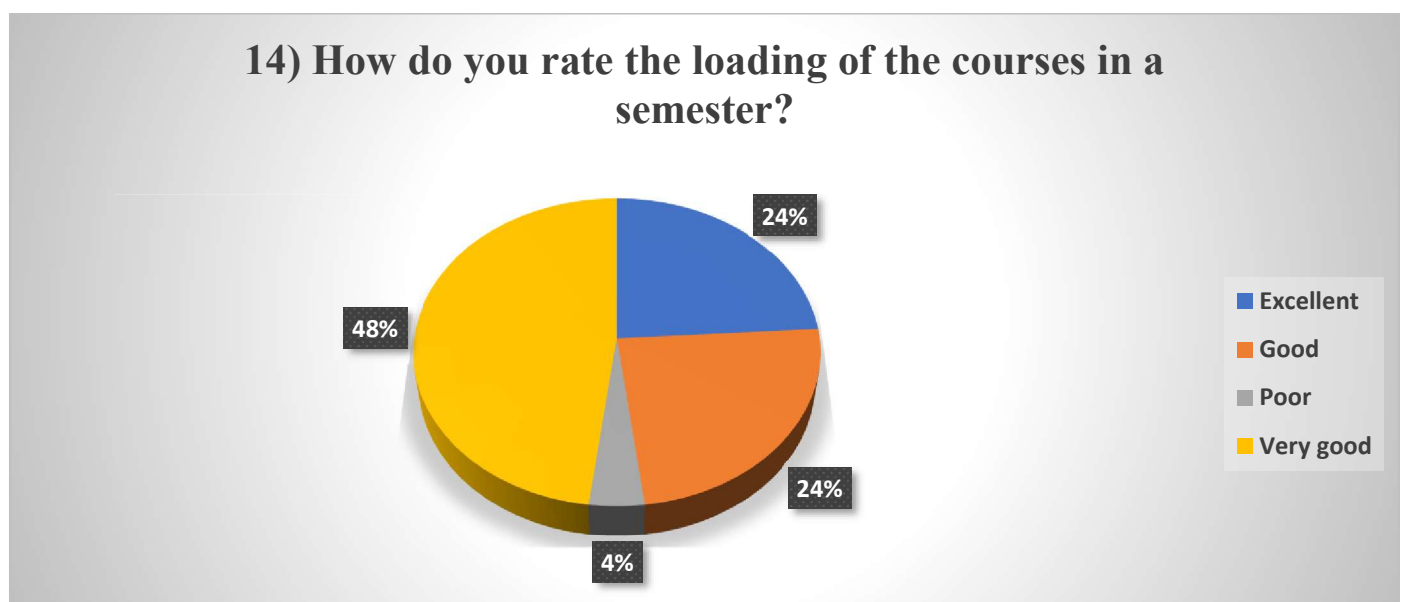
The above pie chart shows that 92% of teachers agreed that the syllabus is practically useful. 8% of teachers do not decide whether the syllabus is practically useful.

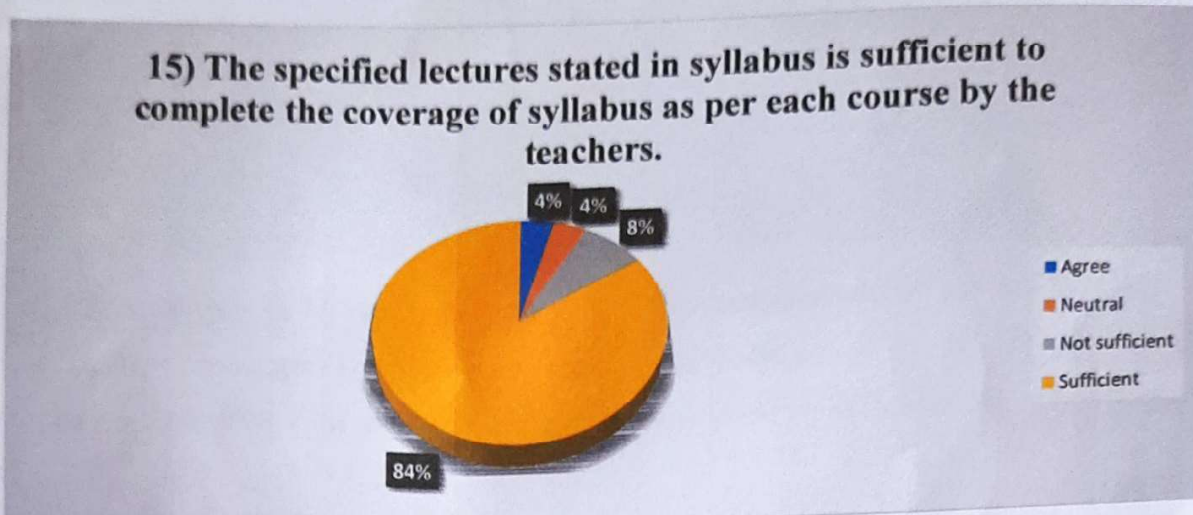
Loading of the Courses in a Semester:

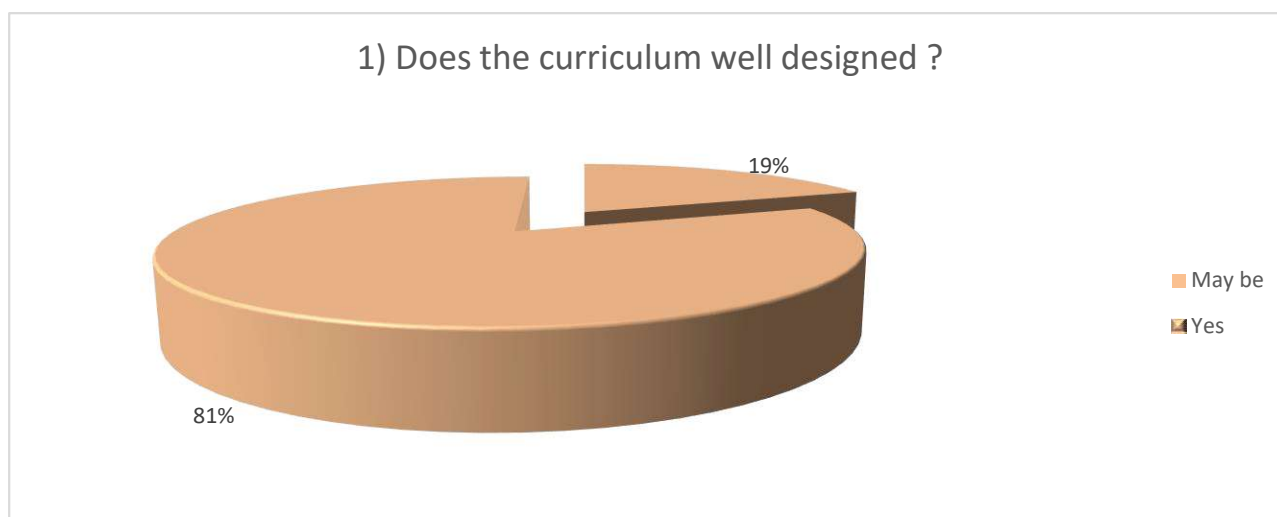

Curriculum Structure: -

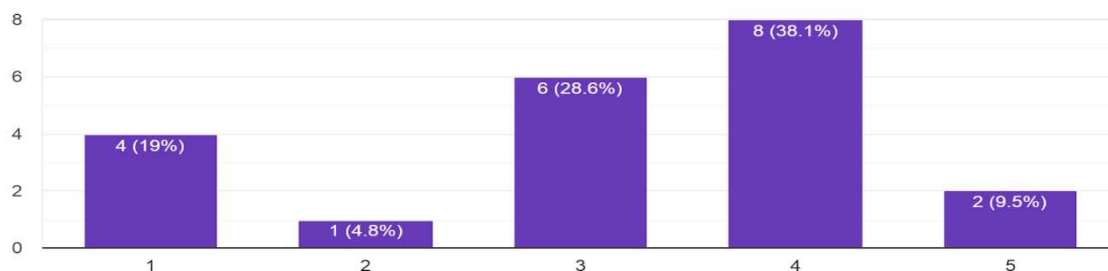


According to the above pie chart, 81% of students mentioned that the syllabus is well designed and 19% of students think that the curriculum may be probably good no

Curriculum and current trend: -

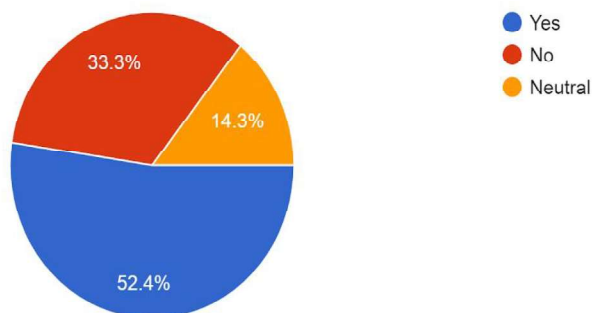
2) At what extent curriculum is matched to current trends?

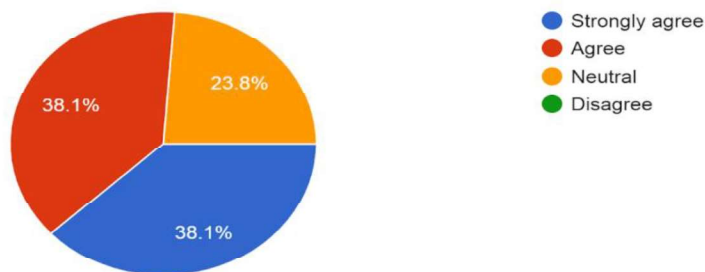

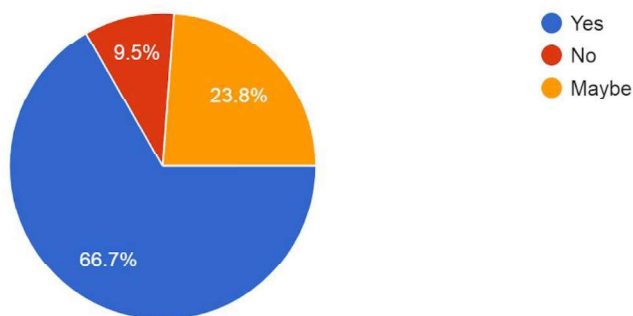


According to alumni opinion, 38.1% strongly agree that curriculum fulfills expectations and 38.1% agree, 23.8% of alumni neutral about the above statement.

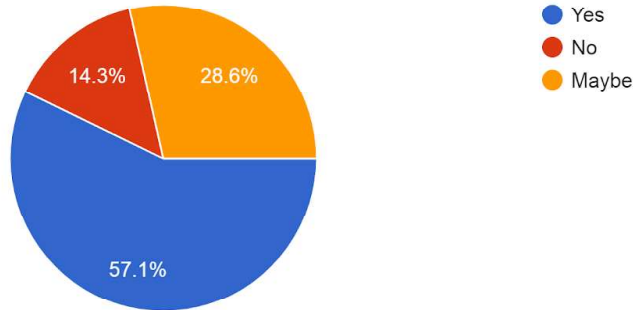

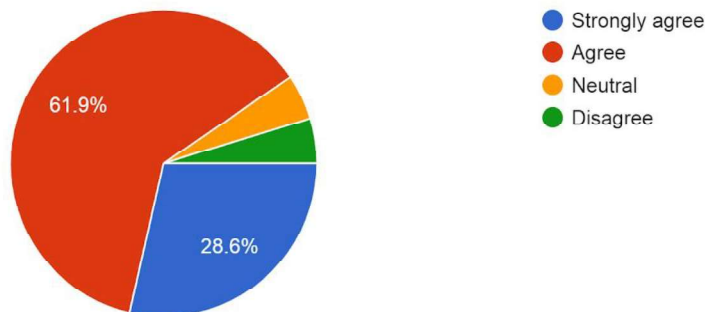

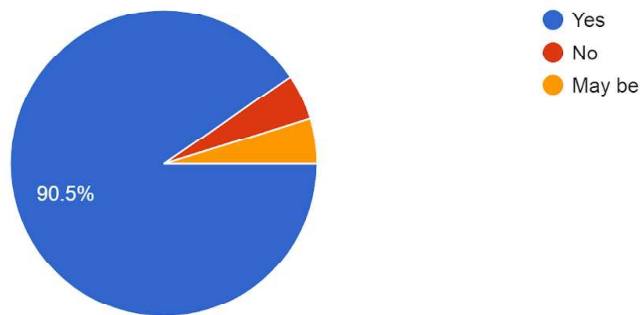
