Every year our teachers publish their research papers in reputed journals and also publish their research articles in books with ISBN, also edit the books and publish own authored books. Our Institution encourages the Staff Members to some extent.

The institution has Three Teachers recognized as research guides viz Dr. Anil Kumar Singh, Dr. S.G. Sagar and Dr. Gautam G. Sonwane. 06 research scholars are doing research under the guidance of Dr. Anil Kumar Singh and 01 under the guidance of Dr. Gautam G. Sonwane. Dr. Anil Kumar Singh and Dr. Gautam G. Sonwane invited as External Referees for and Ph.D. Viva Voce.

Under the guidance of Dr. Anil Kumar Singh, HOD of Hindi Department, the college runs a research Centre in Hindi. It is the only Centre of this kind in the tribal and remote area of Thane District.

Department of History organizes course on Historical Research & Sources and Department of Economics organizes course on Research Methodology in Economics and conducts seminars, workshops for the purpose of research work, soft skills and career counselling for students and teachers. Department of B.sc IT and Department of English organizes activities to develop creativity and Entrepreneurship skill in the students, like; elocution competition, quiz competitions, essay competition, for creative mind.

At Post Graduate level, all courses have special subject on research project proposal and our professors give guidelines regarding the research methodology to PG students. A college magazine portraying the creative talents of students, along with contribution from teachers, offers them with the opportunity to share their knowledge and skills and provides them ample volume of student.

Library is lifeline of Teaching and Learning process. The college has a total of 50711 books and 35 journals and 08 magazines, considering that the reading culture should be awakened among the students and research students of rural areas like Shahapur.
