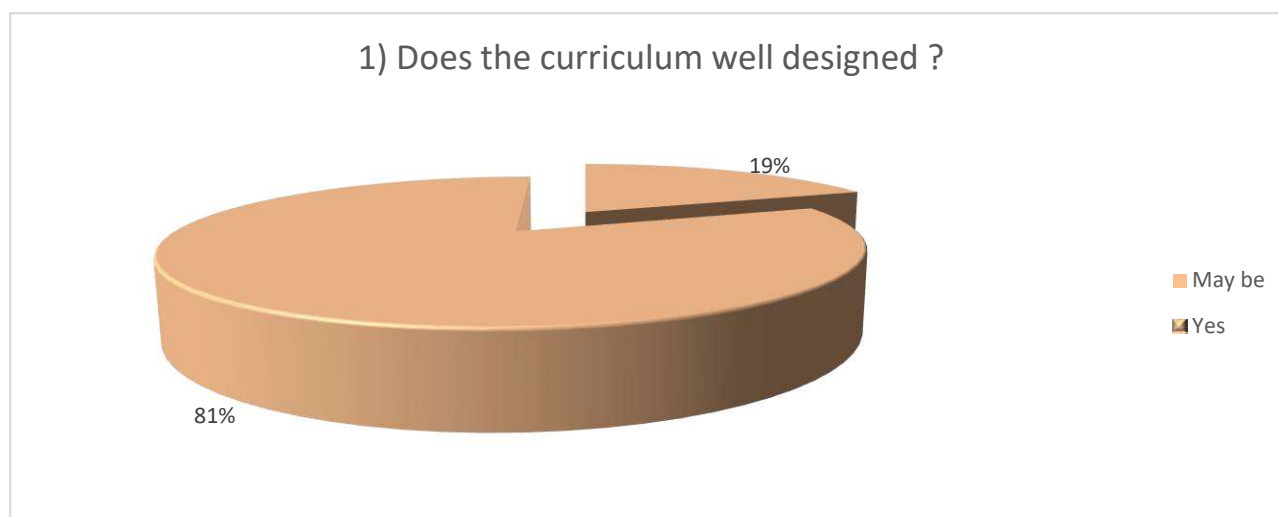

### Curriculum Structure: -

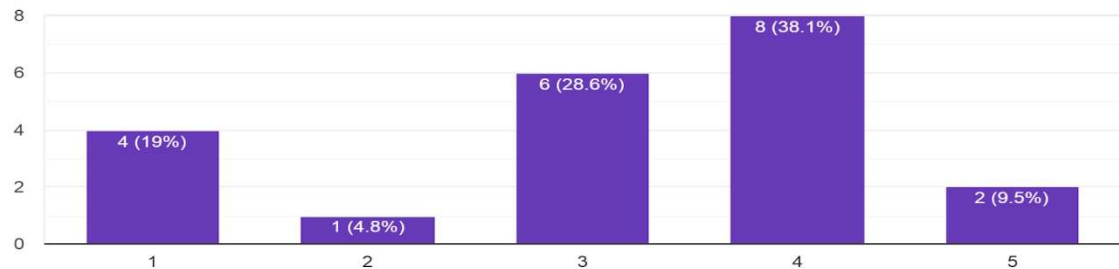


According to the above pie chart, 81% of students mentioned that the syllabus is well designed and 19% of students think that the curriculum may be probably good no

### Curriculum and current trend: -

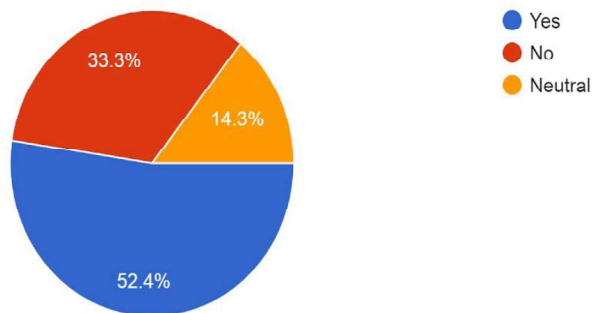
2) At what extent curriculum is matched to current trends?

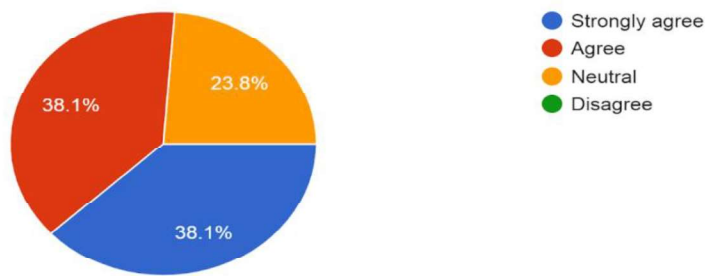

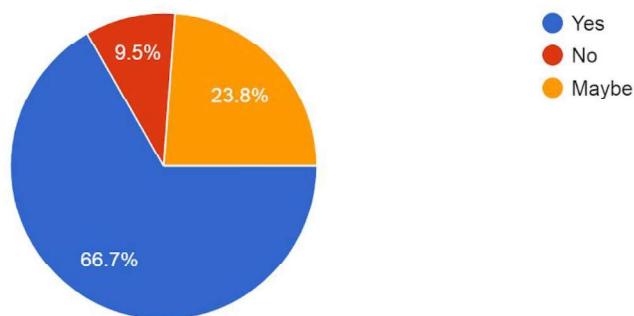


According to alumni opinion, 38.1% strongly agree that curriculum fulfills expectations and 38.1% agree, 23.8% of alumni neutral about the above statement.

21 responses

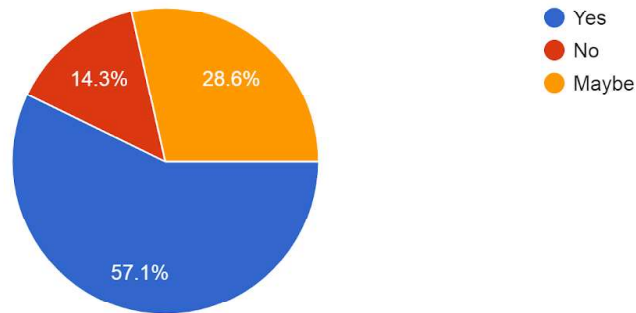

21 responses

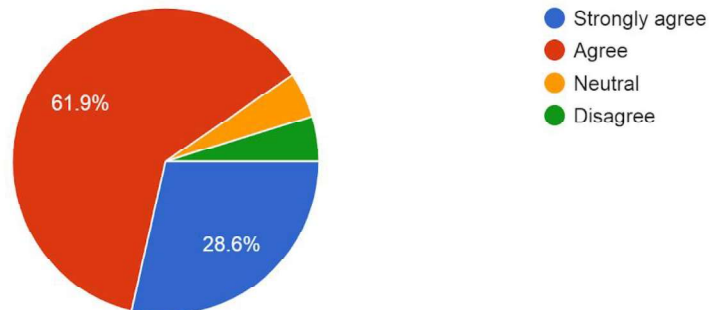

21 responses

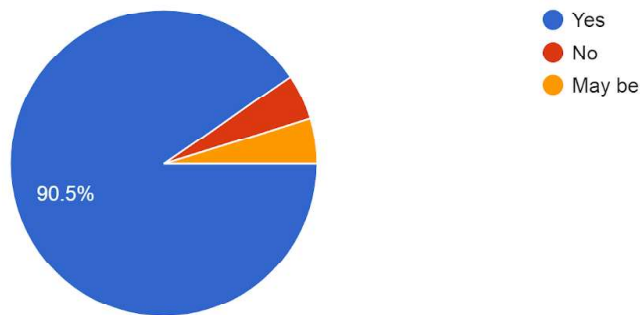

8) Whether the syllabus is useful for post graduation / research in the particular subject?

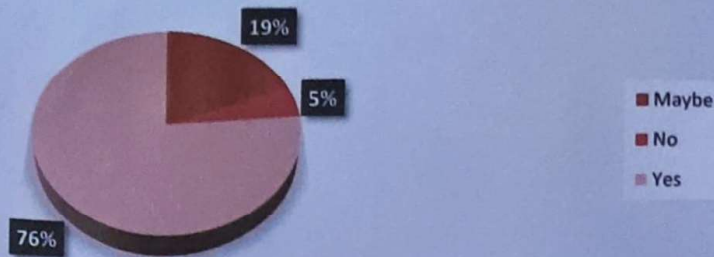
